

One Philly Fund Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who will be administering the Fund?

The One Philly Fund will be administered by the Philadelphia City Fund, an independent 501(c)(3) charitable nonprofit organization that serves as the dedicated fiscal sponsor for the City of Philadelphia.

2. How can I donate to the Fund?

3. Will all funds go directly to survivors of disasters in Philadelphia?

Yes, however, a small fee will go to pay the cost of processing the payment.

4. How do I apply for assistance from the fund?

Survivors impacted by the January 31, 2025, airplane disaster may submit a request to receive assistance from the One Philly Fund by completing the online application form posted at:

5. What if I need help filling out the application?

Please email onephillyfund@phila.gov or go to Northeast Philadelphia Emergency City Hall located inside Roosevelt Plaza.

6. If I am a recipient of the funds, how will I get the money?

The money can be directly deposited into a bank account, or you can receive a paper check.

7. How much money will I receive?

The amount of money that applicants will receive will depend on several factors, including, but not limited to, the amount collected, the severity of the injury to person or property, and the need of the individual.
